

Prasar Bharati is doing the current recruitment for approximately 2400 personnel. We are presently working on pre-appointment formalities such as medical examination, character and antecedents verification. Simultaneously, we are also working on the postings, training etc.

We understand the concerns of the recommended candidates and have taken several steps to address the same. We have already posted on AIR's website the lists of those candidates from whom the filled in attestation forms have not been received back. The attestation form is also available for download. Such candidates who have not received the attestation forms so far may download the same, fill in and return at the earliest.

We have received medical reports in respect of a good number of candidates but the police verifications are taking time. The reason being that the process is time-consuming, especially when candidates have given more than one, and sometimes 2-4 residential addresses. Rules require that the verification is done at all the addresses at which a candidate has resided in the last 5 years. Normally, police verification takes 2-3 months. However, there has been some confusion among the recommended candidates about non-receipt of the verification forms at the District Authorities Offices. All such candidates who are facing any difficulty in this regard may communicate to us the kind of problem they are facing. They may communicate the address of the District Authority in case there is any confusion about the address to which we have sent the forms and thereafter cooperate with the authorities in completing the verification.

We will shortly be uploading the list of all those candidates in respect of whom both medical and police verification process have been completed.

For such candidates who are already in Government Service/PSUs in Group 'B' or above posts, if similar verification has been done earlier, they may send us those documents through their current employer. Others will have to get the police verification done afresh.

As the candidates are to be posted in different stations/Kendras all over India and also require to be trained in batches, it is an administrative requirement for us at Prasar Bharati to induct the candidates in lots of 100 numbers. **The date of appointment does not affect the rank and seniority of the candidates.**

The postings will be done as per the vacancy position/language/specialisation/home town and other such parameters.

Training will be given after appointment and will again be in batches at Delhi and Bhubaneswar (for technicians only at Bhubaneswar).
